Similarities:

- BOTH are governed by the CAAT (A) Collective Agreement.

Differences:

- Full Time
 - Thirteen to eighteen contact hours per week
 - Workload is governed by Article 11
 - Full Benefits
- Partial Load
 - Six to Twelve contact hours per week
 - Workload is governed by Article 26
 - Partial Benefits (see Article 26)
