

Question:

What Did the Workload Task Force recommend for Modified Workloads?

Answer:

The Workload Task Force's report recommended implementing Modified Workload Agreements on the following conditions:

1. Any faculty member may choose not to be a part of the modified workload arrangement.
2. A course's workload must still be carefully measured, analyzing factors like class size, methods of evaluation, and preparation time
3. The total number of hours worked by a professor—which would be measured according to the SWF—could not exceed the number worked in the previous year
4. The union gives its consent (which may not be unreasonably withheld) to the modified arrangement.
